Mourning Hope Grief Center Resources

The Mourning Hope Grief Center companions children, adults and families before and after a death loss. Mourning Hope provides grief support groups, counseling, community education, resources and referrals, all at absolutely no cost.

There is not one way to grieve. That is why Mourning Hope offers a broad range of programs and services that can be tailored to the unique circumstances of the individual and the death.

Forming the foundation of Mourning Hope's program offerings, peer-based grief support groups help participants find hope and connection. Available for a range of ages, these diverse programs include:

Family Grief Support Groups

For children, teens and their adult caregivers.

Young Adult Grief Support Groups

Designed for individuals spanning the transitional period between late teens and twenties.

Camp Erin® Lincoln

A free, overnight bereavement camp for youth who are grieving the death of a significant person in their lives. Children and teens ages 6 to 17 attend a weekend camp experience that combines grief education and emotional support with fun, traditional camp activities.

Adult Grief Support Groups

For adults who have experienced the death of someone significant in their lives.

Survivors of Suicide Loss Support Groups

For adults who have experienced a suicide death.

School-Based Grief Support Groups

For students ages kindergarten through high school seniors.

Counseling

In a group or individual setting, Mourning Hope's licensed counseling team helps children, adults and families learn healthy coping skills and ways to process their grief.

Resources & Referrals

Mourning Hope has an extensive resource library of brochures, activity books, journals and more.

Family Camp

A free, overnight bereavement camp to support families who have experienced the death of someone significant in their lives. Families explore their grief, learn coping skills and make connections with other families through camp activities.

Holiday Hope

Local artists work with youth while adults meet separately to learn how to navigate the often-difficult holiday season.

Art from Our Heart

One-day grief support event for youth to express their thoughts and emotions through art.
