Forming the foundation of Mourning Hope's program offerings, peer-based grief support groups help participants find hope and connection. Available for all ages, these diverse programs include:

Family Grief Support Groups

For children, teens and their adult caregivers.

Young Adult Grief Support Groups

For ages 19 to 30ish.

Adult Grief Support Groups

For ages 30+.

Survivors of Suicide Loss Support Groups

For adults who have experienced a suicide death.

School-Based Grief Support Groups

For students ages kindergarten through high school seniors.

Counseling

In a group or individual setting, Mourning Hope's licensed counseling team helps children, adults and families learn healthy coping skills and ways to process their grief.
