

In FYE 2023, Mourning Hope served 1,796 unique individuals; a 14.8% increase in direct service utilization over FYE 2022, following a 30% increase the prior fiscal year.

 That's 221 grief counseling clients

 That's 583 grief consultations

 That's 992 grief support group participants

Mourning Hope also provided 194 community grief presentations in FYE 2023, reaching an additional 3,986 individuals.

Receiving no government funding or insurance reimbursement for programs, Mourning Hope relies solely on private donations from individuals, businesses, service clubs and foundations in order to provide **no-cost** services to those who need it most.

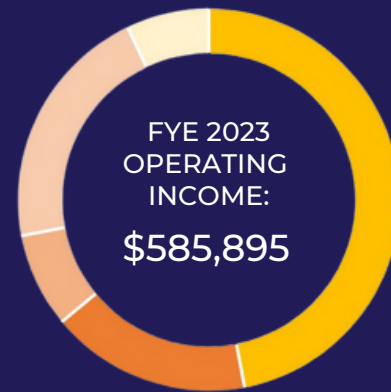
