

In FYE 2021, Mourning Hope served 1,203 unique individuals; an 89.7% increase in direct service utilization over last fiscal year.

👥 That's 168 grief counseling clients

👤 That's 190 grief consultations

👥 That's 845 grief support group participants

Because of virtual programming options, Mourning Hope was able to provide grief support to people in **37 states** and **11 countries**.

Mourning Hope also provided **101 community grief presentations** in FYE 2021.

Receiving no government funding or insurance reimbursement, Mourning Hope relies solely on private donations from individuals, businesses, service clubs and foundations in order to provide no-cost services to those who need it most.

- ☀️ The 2021 Children's Bereavement Estimation Model results estimate 13.3 million children will lose a parent or sibling by age 25 (Judi's House/JAG Institute). These staggering results were derived from pre-pandemic mortality data. As our world continues to settle into a new normal, we know demand for bereavement care will only increase.
- ☀️ In 2022, Mourning Hope will be called upon to mitigate the secondary pandemic; a vast increase in persons facing complicated grief reactions related to COVID-19.
